- * All requests for inspection shall be made at least ONE (1) working day prior to inspection
- * Owner is responsible for ensuring all to be inspected shall be safely accessible to inspectors. Stairs/ladders shall be of OSHA approved construction
- * No corrections shall be made in the approved plans without the approval of the Building Safety Official. No work shall be done which are not shown in the approved plans without approval from the Building Safety Official. BSCD approved plans and this checklist shall be available on site at all times
- * All compressive strength test result of concrete cylinder samples for footings/columns/beams /slabs for each pouring shall be submitted to assure that the design strength of the concrete has been attained. This is a requirement before any certificate of occupancy is granted
- * The completed building shall not be occupied until a certificate of occupancy is granted. Occupying the building without the issuance of certificate of occupancy will be subject to fines and or civil prosecution.
